### **Report cards**

GIS reports to parents on their child's performance in a variety of ways, including report cards, which are issued at the end of Semester 1 and Semester 2. Previously, Semester 1 at GIS ended just before the Christmas break, which resulted in two unequal semesters. Please note that in order to provide more balance, from this year on Semester 1 will end in mid-January. This academic year, the last day of Semester 1 is 18 January 2018. As a result, report cards will be issued then.

### **Privacy and Security on Managebac**

Schools all over the world use software platforms to assist teacher curriculum planning, assessment and reporting. Reputable systems like Managebac, which is endorsed by the IB, are conscious of digital privacy and regulate access to information through passwords and/or pins.

Not every user will see guite the same, connected information.

#### Students and parents are considered 'service users'

Students will have access to a modified version of the curriculum, and student resources including assignments. Their interaction with the school is controlled through drop boxes, so their assignments cannot be seen by others, nor the feedback they receive. This offers vastly superior privacy to traditional systems including hard copies of marked work that may be left lying around a classroom. However, students need to remember to upload their work in the right section of ManageBac, i.e. in TASKS, not in MESSAGES. We will keep reminding students about the rule.

Parents, likewise have access to a modified version of the curriculum, and details such as the reports of their own children only. Practical advice on how to access the service, as a parent, was recently presented at a morning tea by Paul Venter, the school's MYP Coordinator.

#### **Teachers and Administrators are considered 'school users'**

In addition to keeping each other informed about each other's work, including the pressures of assessment on children, teachers sometimes use it to message individuals or groups. None of the recipients will see each other's details, however.
