## **PYP Reading Challenge**

Welcome back to another fun filled semester in the GIS Library. We recently started up a new reading incentive program involving points for minutes read. Students are asked to read up to 30 or 40 minute blocks (depending upon their grade level) at a time. This block can be divided up as you see fit. In the library, we read for approximately 10 minutes during a lesson. This time may be counted towards their reading goal.

As stated in the brochure handed out to PYP students recently, anything to do with reading will count, including: audiobooks (Spotify and YouTube have excellent titles available), reading homework (both English and Norwegian), Buddy Reading, being read to, reading to others all count towards the reading goal. One can also find excellent Story Time Books on YouTube under **Cheebies Bedtime Story**. Students are reminded that they can come after school or during breaks to the library to exchange their books for new titles. Reading Challenge Booklets need to be brought in for their library session.

Please remember that the Reading Challenge Booklets need to be filled out correctly to earn points. Colour in the books inside the booklet to keep track of reading completed. At the end of the week, please send to school a Reading Challenge Booklet, which has the number of minutes read for the entire week in the one box and a parent signature bellow it.
