Enrichment in the MYP

Teachers of MYP students at GIS have always sought to enhance teaching and learning for their students with field trips, guest speakers and special events (such as the Sleepover and the recent Winter Activities Day). This year, partly because our curriculum now encompasses four years, we have collated a list of these enrichment activities for our systematic reflection and future planning. Over the past eight months, we have offered examples of 24 such items to individual classes, year groups, the MYP or to the school as a whole!

The most recent offering was the Brødrene Masai – interactive dance performance provided by Kulturelle skolesekken in the school kitchen last Monday after lunch. Grade 8 and 9 students (with a few volunteers from Grade 7) were introduced to Brazilian culture through dance, stories and the performances. Our students participated enthusiastically and now 'have the rhythm'!
