PYP Student-led Conferences: 25th April 2019

For anyone new to this, please note that the format is different from a parent-teacher conference. Essentially, it is a scheduled opportunity for you as parents to sit with your child and share a collection of work samples they have gathered in their individual portfolio. This is their moment to share selected pieces and experiences that illustrate their personal strengths, areas for improvement and/or things that make them especially proud.

As a result of the conference, it is our hope that families will celebrate learning milestones and also take time to create goals and strategies for supporting student growth and improvement.

Each child will lead their own 45 minute session, and teachers will be nearby to facilitate if needed. Parent discussion questions will also be available as suggestions, to help stimulate rich dialogue. Currently, all Grade 1-5 students are preparing and practicing for conferences.

Please find attached to this newsletter a timetable of conferences. We have scheduled siblings' conferences back to back to eliminate/reduce waiting time for parents. The remaining conferences were scheduled randomly. Please feel free to swap slots with other families if you are not available at the assigned time. Please contact the parents you want to swap with directly.

Also attached to this newsletter, you will find a set of sample questions, which, we hope, help you prepare for the conference. By no means is the list prescriptive or exhaustive. We feel that going through it item by item would be artificial. The conference should be informative but based on genuine interaction. Therefore, please use the questions only as a starting point.

Also, please note that the questions are not meant for a specific grade level, so you may need to adapt some of them to your child's age. There is no expectation for the conferences to take place in English. We recommend that you use the language that best lends itself to an effective exchange of information in a relaxed atmosphere. The conference should be a positive experience for students – it is not an exam.

Pease note that there will be no classes or swimming for PYP students (Grade 1-5) on 25th April and childcare will be provided ONLY to families with two or more children and ONLY for the duration of the respective conferences. Swimming is cancelled on 25th April. MYP students (Grade 6-9) will have classes as usual on25th April 2019.

We hope the conferences are a positive experience for you and your child, and give you yet another perspective on your child's learning.

Please note that there may be up to four conferences taking place simultaneously in a classroom.
