# Student-led conferences: thank you!

Thank you for attending PYP student-led conferences last week. We hope you enjoyed your conference(s) and found out more about your child's learning this academic year.

### 17th May Celebrations

We hope many families join us to celebrate Constitution Day on 17<sup>th</sup> May. GIS will join the parade in town in the morning. Please ensure you are at Gjøvik Stadium at 9:45am for a prompt start. This year, we have been placed between Gjøvik Læringssenter and Gjøvik Vgd Skole. Look out for our banner! To ensure safety and appropriate conduct, we would like to ask for your support. We need two parent volunteers per grade level from Grade 1 to Grade 5 to assist a class during

We would also like to ask parents to remind children that the parade is a formal event and through appropriate behavior we show respect for our host country. Therefore, we expect students to walk in an orderly fashion and use national symbols, especially flags, with respect. We also strongly discourage children from picking up *russekort*, whose content is often inappropriate for young children. The parade ends at Gjøvik Gård. Please collect your child there as soon as we arrive as we will not be able to ensure safety for the large GIS group in the crowd that will gather there.

Following the parade, GIS Parent Council invites everyone to a picnic and activities at GIS. Please find attached an invitation from Parent Council. Please note that Grade 9 will continue to raise money for their trip to Berlin in September 2019. We hope you can support the students.

#### **MYP** verification visit
