The password is a combination of a school created password (961ch) and the child's name. Please pay attention to the upper case and lower case letter combination.

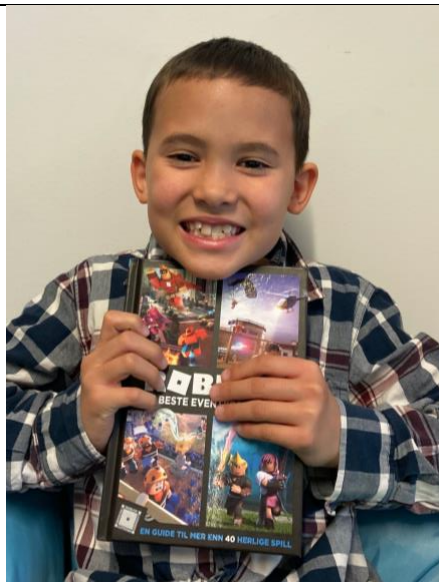
For example: Login barcode is 1234. Password is 961chBiBi
