Winter bus card for students in Grades 1-4

We are pleased to inform you that the students in Grades 1-4 can now apply for a free seasonal (winter) bus card for next academic year, which will be valid from October 2021 until April 2022. Application forms can be found here. Please note that the application needs to be stamped at GIS, so please send it to us via your child's class teacher and we will forward it to the right office. The deadline for applications is 20 February 2021.

The students who live more than four kilometres away from the school are entitled to a card. However, the families who live within four kilometres of GIS are required to explain in writing why their child needs a bus card and they are not guaranteed a bus card. Please remember to attach your explanation to your application.
