Dismissal: reminder

In order to ensure your child is safe when they leave school at the end of the day, we need to receive accurate information regarding pickup from parents in a timely fashion. We fully understand that last minutes changes are unavoidable. If you are unable to inform the class teacher by email by 2:30pm about changes to your pickup arrangements, please call the school office to ensure the information is received and passed on to the relevant teacher.

Also, we would like to take this opportunity to remind parents that we are unable to inform the taxi company of changes to students' schedules. It is the responsibility of the parents to ensure that the service is cancelled when children do not need it.

PYP parent-teacher conferences

PYP parent-teacher conferences will take place on 23, 24 and 25 March 2021 after classes. A timetable of all meetings was shared with parents last week. If you swap meetings with another family, please remember to inform the class teacher of the change.

All conferences will take place online.

MYP parent-teacher conferences

MYP parent-teacher conferences will take place on 7 and 8 April 2021 after classes. MYP teachers are available by appointment. Like last semester, conferences will be pre-booked with relevant teachers if an area of concern has been identified for a student. The parents of remaining students are not required to attend conferences. However, they can sign up for selected conferences using our online booking system. Parents will receive a checklist for each child next week. Each teacher has assessed the student on a set of criteria, including overall achievement, participation in class activities, ability to follow instructions, etc. More information regarding available times will be provided with the checklists.

MYP parent-teacher conferences will take place via an online platform. More details will follow soon.

Next academic year: reminder

Even though it is only March, we are now at the stage when we are planning in more detail for next academic year. We are also obliged to inform educational

1. School Calendar

The calendar outlines holidays, professional development days, etc. We tried to align the calendar with that of national schools as much as possible. However, you will notice several differences, e.g. our Christmas break is slightly longer in order to accommodate our international staff and students.

2. Half Day

As usual, one day a week classes will end at 12:00pm. We expect the half day to remain on Thursday but this is subject to change if we are assigned a different time at Fjellhallen when it reopens.

3. Tuition fees

As decided by the School Board tuition fees for 2021-2022 remain the same as this academic year and will be 2650 NOK (Grade 1-7) and 2850NOK (Grade 8-10). Like before, the fees will be paid 11 times a year.
