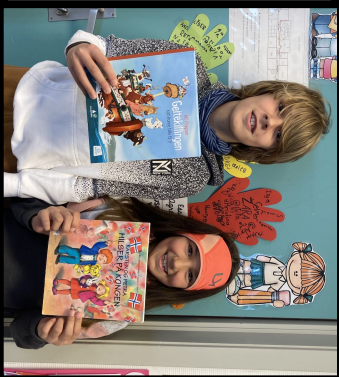


ISBC THANK YOU
