- Art Education and Conservation -

Similarly, to environmental conservation, conservation in a museum works towards preserving our world and history but focuses on cultural heritage. Art Conservators prevent harm from happening to art works and act when damage occurs. Their work is carried out in museums together with curators, collection, design, and exhibition professionals from other departments. Art Matters program focuses on art conservation and provide access to age-appropriate experiences within the museum ecosystem. Activities include understanding of different art works, storytelling, exploration of materials, virtual visits to conservation laboratories and interaction with art conservators worldwide.
